Unveiling of Colombian Sculpture Garden, Dante Fascell Park

WHAT: The City of South Miami will be unveiling three sculptures as part of its new Colombian Sculpture Garden. The Colombian Sculpture Garden is designed to highlight Colombian artists by gracing Dante Fascell Park with an Art in Public Places initiatives that will include appropriate programming. The sculptures were donated by Artists Dr. Santiago Medina, Luis Jimenez, and Carlos Silva as part of the Sister City partnership between the City of South Miami and Medellin, Colombia. Said partnership was spearheaded by South Miami Commissioner Josh Liebman. South Miami is the first city in Miami-Dade County to have a Sister City partnership with Medellin.
