NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC OF A SOUTH MIAMI POLICE OFFICERS' RETIREMENT TRUST

In order to balance the need for the City of South Miami to function and conduct vital business during the COVID 19 pandemic and, at the same time, to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens, elected and appointed officers and officials and administrative staff, and pursuant to the City of South Miami Code, Chapter 286.011, Fla. Stat, and Executive Order Number 20-69, the City shall conduct its meetings virtually through communications media technology (CMT) until the state of emergency has ended or social distancing is no longer required by any relevant Executive Orders.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that that the City of South Miami Police Officers' Retirement Trust will be holding a virtual meeting on **April 30, 2020 at 9:00 AM** Eastern Time (US and Canada) using communication media technology (CMT), to discuss the following topic(S): **Board Quarterly Business** .

Please note that Governor DeSantis' Executive Order Number 20-69 suspended the requirements of Section 166.045, Fla. Stat., that a quorum to be present in person, and that a local government body meet at a specific public place. The Executive Order also allows local government bodies to utilize communications media technology, such as telephonic and video conferencing such as Zoom for meetings of local government bodies. Note that pursuant to Florida Statutes 286.0105, a person who decides to appeal any decision made by a Board, Agency or Commission with respect to any matter considered at its meeting or hearing, a record of the proceedings will be required for said appeal and such person will be required to have a verbatim transcript of the proceedings including the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based ADA: To request a modification to a policy, practice or procedure or to request an auxiliary aide or service in order to participate in a City program, activity or event, you must on or before 4:00 p.m./a.m. on 4/27¹ 2020 deliver your request to the City Clerk by telephone: 305-722-8686 (voice) or 305-442-1600 (TTY/TDD) or by mail at 6130 Sunset Drive, South Miami, Florida or email at npayne@southmiamifl.gov.
